24 HOUR TIME (MILITARY TIME)

Military time is used by Clearfield County Communications Center to avoid any confusion that may arise between AM and PM. The following is a reference guide in the difference between the 12 hour clock and the 24 hour clock. Also, you will find the correct language to use when speaking in military time.

<u>2400</u>	Hour Time Table
0000	12:00 AM Beginning of day (twenty four hundred hours)
0001	One minute after midnight (zero zero zero one hours)
0015	Fifteen minutes after midnight (zero zero fifteen hours)
0045	45 minutes after midnight (zero zero forty-five hours)
0100	1 AM (zero one hundred hours)
0130	1:30 AM (zero one thirty hours)
0200	2 AM (zero two hundred hours)
1000	10 AM (ten hundred hours)
1100	11 AM (eleven hundred hours)
1200	NOON (twelve hundred hours)
1300	1:00 PM (thirteen hundred hours)
1330	1:30 PM (thirteen thirty hours)
1345	1:45 PM (thirteen forty five hours)
2300	11 PM (twenty-three hundred hours)
2359	11:59 PM (twenty-three fifty-nine hours)
0000	12:00 AM (twenty four hundred hours)
